THE 3- 6- 5 CHALLENGE

The 3- 6- 5 Challenge is a church wide initiative designed to encourage the members of Berkeley Mt. Zion to set three simple, measurable goals that, if achieved, are proven steps toward a closer walk with God. Here is the challenge: With God's help, I make the following commitment.



3

I will share the Gospel / Disciple three people in the next six months.

6

I maintain a personal devotional time six times in a week.

5

I will practice the five spiritual disciplines (Prayer, Fasting, Reading, Stewardship, Service).



PERSONAL DISCIPLESHIP PLAN

As we follow Christ, He transforms our minds, our desires, our wills, our relationships, and our ultimate reason for living. Every disciple of Jesus exists to make disciples of Jesus, here and among every people group on the planet. There are no spectators. We are all born to reproduce the life of Christ in others. So how are you going to reproduce?

The purpose in asking this question is to spur you on to consider how the life of Christ in you might be multiplied through you in the world. Our prayer is for every follower of Christ in our church to have an intentional plan for following Jesus and leading others to become fully devoted followers of Jesus.

So, consider the following six straightforward questions. After a brief overview, there are sub-questions with space provided to answer. As you consider these questions, they will help you flesh out what it means to follow Jesus in six significant ways. These questions are not exhaustive, but they are essential. Our hope and prayer is that they will inspire us to consider what it means to be disciples of Jesus and make disciples of Jesus.

HOW WILL I FILL MY MIND WITH TRUTH?

The life of the disciple is the life of a learner. We constantly attune our ears to the words of our Master. As He teaches us through His Word, He transforms us in the world.

Consider a plan for reading, memorizing, and learning God's Word, but don't forget that disciples do these things not for information, but for transformation.

HOW WILL I READ GOD'S WORD?

You might start with a plan to read a chapter a day, or you could consider using an intentional Bible reading plan that covers all of Scripture over a certain period of time. You can explore a list of suggested Bible reading guides at:

HOW WILL I MEMORIZE GOD'S WORD?

As you read, look for verses, paragraphs, or even chapters that seem particularly significant and applicable to your life. Then commit them to memory. Maybe you can start by memorizing a verse a week, and then eventually take on more.

HOW WILL I LEARN GOD'S WORD FROM OTHERS?

Reading, studying, and understanding the Bible is not just an individual effort; it's a community project. We all need pastors who are teaching God's Word faithfully to us and brothers and sisters in Christ who are consistently encouraging us with God's Word.

2 HOW WILL I FUEL MY AFFECTIONS FOR GOD?

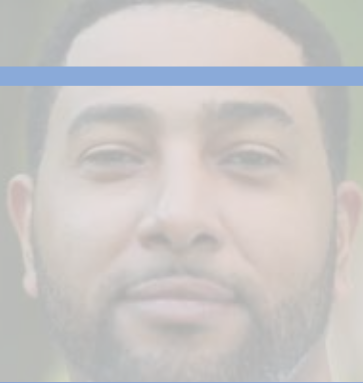
There is a dangerous tendency for discipline in the disciple's life to become mechanical and monotonous. Our aim is not simply to know God; our aim is to love God, and the more we read His Word, the more we delight in His glory. Our aim in other spiritual disciplines is similar. As we worship, pray, fast, and give, we fuel affection for God. It is impossible to separate true faith in Christ from profound feelings for Christ. As disciples of Jesus, we intentionally worship, pray, fast, and give in order to fuel affection for God.

HOW WILL I PRAY?

Find yourself a place and set aside a time to be with the Father. The 3- 6- 5 Challenge encourages everyone to spend quality time alone with God every day. Concentrated prayer at a specific time is the best fuel for continual prayer all the time. Simply setting aside this time and place will substantially change your life as a disciple of Jesus.

Consider a space where you can make your prayer audible. There is power in declaring God's promises over yourself and those you're praying for in Jesus' name.

In addition to your daily prayer time, we need to pray together.



HOW WILL I FAST?

Once a week or once every few weeks, instead of eating breakfast, lunch, or dinner, spend an hour praying and reading God's Word. Once you've grown accustomed to this practice, plan to fast for two meals in one day, and then for an entire 24- hour period. Once a quarter during the year, we'll participate corporately in a day of prayer and fasting.

HOW WILL I GIVE?

One of the most effective ways to fuel affection for God is to give your resources in obedience to God. Giving intentionally, generously, sacrificially, and cheerfully fuels selfless love for God that overcomes selfish desires for the things of this world.

3 HOW WILL I SHARE GOD'S LOVE AS A WITNESS IN THE WORLD?

God's will in the world and for our lives is to spread His gospel, grace, and glory to all peoples. Instead of asking what God's will is for our lives, every disciple of Jesus asks, "How can my life align with His will for me to be His witness in the world?" Every person that God has graciously put around you is a sinner eternally in need of a Savior. You were once that person, yet someone intentionally sought you out to share the gospel with you. And now this is the purpose for which God has graciously created, saved, and blessed you. With the Word of God in your mouth and the Spirit of God in your heart, end your quest to find God's will by deciding today to follow it.

WHO?

Take some time to write down the names of three, five, or maybe ten unbelievers or unchurched people God has placed in your life. Then begin praying specifically for God, through the power of His Spirit, to draw them to His salvation and to use you to share the gospel with them.

WHEN?

It's wise to consider how you can actively show Christ's love by creating opportunities to tell people about Jesus. Think about the people you identified above and how you can specifically and deliberately create opportunities to share the gospel with them. As part of the 3-6-5 Challenge, we are asking everyone to share the Gospel with three people over the next six months.

4 HOW WILL I SHOW GOD'S LOVE AS A MEMBER OF A CHURCH?

The Bible flies in the face of the individualism of our culture and church consumerism, prompting every follower of Christ to ask the question, "Am I committed to a local church where I am sharing life with other followers of Christ?" To follow Christ is to love His church. It is biblically, spiritually, and practically impossible to be a disciple of Christ (much less make disciples of Christ) apart from devoting yourself to a family of Christians.

WHERE?

Think about where you can most effectively serve and make disciples of Christ and lock arms with others, not as a spectator on the sidelines, but as a participant in the mission.

WHAT?

As you look at Berkeley Mt. Zion, consider what things you can do to build up the body of Christ here and what you will do to make sure that you have people who are watching out for your life in Christ. Identify specific ways that you will clearly express the love of Christ in and through the church.

5 HOW WILL I MAKE DISCIPLE- MAKERS AMONG A FEW PEOPLE?

Jesus spent his life investing in a few people. His strategy for reaching all peoples was clear: make disciple- makers among a few people. God will lead us to live in all kinds of different places in the world. Yet regardless of where we live, the task we have is the same. Every Jesus follower should look around and ask, "How will I make disciple- makers among a few people?"

HOW WILL I BRING THEM IN?

Consider two, three, or four people God has put in your circle of influence whom you can lead to make disciples. Then invite those few people to spend intentional time with you in the days ahead for the express purpose of growing in Christ together.

READY. SET. GO!

READY, SET, GO USE YOUR S.O.A.P.

A systematic Bible reading plan will aid you in developing the discipline of daily Bible reading and journaling. The acronym S.O.A.P. stands for Scripture, Observation, Application, Prayer.

Scripture - Write down what stuck out to you in your reading

Observation - What did you observe about the scripture

Application - How can you apply the observation so that it affects your life today.

Prayer - Write out a prayer to God based on what you just learned and ask Him to help you apply this truth to your life.

The Ready, Set, Go reading plan gives you a choice of reading levels for each day of the year:

Ready – A brief Bible reading (5 minutes or so daily)

Set – A more extensive reading (10- 15 minutes daily)

Go – A daily reading that will take you through the entire Bible in a year, including twice through the New Testament (30- 40 minutes daily)

Develop as many routines as you can relating to your daily Bible reading. The routines give a sense of “comfort” to your commitment and help in the formation of a positive habit.

- Choose a time of day to read.
- Choose the best place available to read.
- Have an alternate plan for non- standard days or for traveling.

AUGUST - SURRENDER

This month focus your prayers on "Surrender".

1 Surrender Ideas, and, Desires - Father, I pray that we would be willing to surrender to your ideas, wants and desires when they are contrary to Your's.

2 Surrender To Your Will - Father, I pray that You would give me the courage to surrender to Your will and ways especially when I don't feel like surrendering...am afraid...or want to sin today.

3 Have Not Surrendered - Father, I pray that I would not be the man/woman who is still troubled, still seeking, or still stuck because I have not surrendered to Your plans during this season of my life.

4 Surrender To Your Work - Father, I pray that when You isolate me for a season I will surrender to what You are doing for it is ALL being done for a greater purpose.

5 Surrender And Yield - Father, I pray that I would surrender and yield to You as the Potter and remember that You are magnificent at what You do, so as the clay, I should let You continue Your masterpiece.

6 Surrender To You - Father, I pray that whatever I am worried about (e.g., child, job, bills, making the right decision, etc.), I now surrender them all to You. Please take care of them.

7 Finished With...And Surrender - Father, I pray that I would be finished with performing, people pleasing or even pretending and surrender to You, the God who sees me, accepts me, and loves me.

8 Surrender To Your Will - Father, I pray that I would have an audience of One - You Lord, and may I be so surrendered to Your will and ways that obeying You is all that matters.

9 Surrender The Outcome To You - Surrender Them - Father, I pray that I would simply be obedient to all that You want me to do and surrender the outcome to You

10. Surrender To Them - Father, I pray that I would surrender my friends, family and enemies to You for I do not have the power to change them....but You do.

11 Surrendered To Your Word - Father, I pray that I am so surrendered to Your Word that I am rooted and grounded in it, nourished by it, and others see the fruit of it.

12 I Would Surrender - Father, I pray that I would surrender and not fight Your will, but let go of what I don't really need anyway.

13 *Surrender To Grief - Father, I pray that in my losses (e.g., family member, job, health, etc.) I will surrender to the grief process for all the grace I need You are there to provide.*

14 *Surrender Anyway - Father, I pray to You knowing that my pride hates surrendering, and my flesh still fights to rule but today I surrender anyway.*

15 *Surrender It All - Father, I pray to You confessing that I have been trying to control certain situations, people and outcomes, but now I surrender them all to You. Today, I repent and ask for forgiveness for stopping Your work and for being in Your way.*

16 *Surrender My Destiny - Father, I pray that I will surrender my destiny to You and be willing to say, "Here I am Lord send me wherever You want."*

17 *Not Surrender To Fear - Father, I pray that I would not surrender to my fears, but by Your power and might triumph over them.*

18 *I Will Still Surrender - Father, I pray that I will still surrender to You when it is painful, when neediness wants what it wants, or when I don't understand why I should have to...because You see the bigger picture and You know what's best for me.*

19 *Surrender Deadlines - Father, I pray that I will surrender my deadlines to You and wait for Your appointed time.*

20 *Surrender Burdens - Father, I pray asking that You would help me to surrender all my burdens and concerns to You because You don't want me to carrying them and they are too heavy anyway.*

21 *Help To Surrender - Father, I pray for help to surrender my will, lay down my pride and finally say, "yes" to You in the places I still want to control in my life.*

22 *Surrender To Temptation - Father, I pray that I would not forget You LORD, and surrender to temptation.*

23 *I Would Surrender Every - Father, I pray that I would surrender every wrongful word, expectation, stereotype, criticism, or judgment that someone placed on me or said to me and I ask You to renew my mind as I let them go.*

24 *Finally Surrender - Father, I pray that I or my (e.g., friend, family, co-worker) would finally surrender, admit my/their wrong(s), and move on instead of remaining stuck, deceived and/or in denial.*

25 *Surrender My Time - Father, I pray that I would surrender my time to You...and place on my calendar what You desire.*

26 Surrender My Finances - Father, I pray that I would surrender my finances to You...pay off debt, save, spend and give away what You desire.

27 Surrender This Day - Father, I arise on this morning and surrender this day to You to do whatever You desire.

28 Surrender My Desire - Father, I pray that if what I want is wrong I surrender that desire to You and ask that You would keep that door closed!

29 Surrender My... - Father, I pray and surrender my children, godchild, niece or nephew to You, may no one pluck them out of Your hands Lord, and may they be used by You all the days of their lives.

30 Surrender My Tomorrows - Father, I pray that I would surrender my tomorrows to You for they are safe in Your hands and today has enough worries of its own.

31 Never Surrender - Father, I pray and declare that from this moment forward I will never surrender to the enemy no matter what.

1 All Done With Love - Father, I pray that as we work and serve at Berkeley Mt. Zion that it would all be done in Love.

2 Love And Be Patient - Father, I pray that I would love others and be patient with them.

3 Loving and Kind - Father, I pray that I would be loving and have kindness towards others without envy or jealousy.

4 Love Present - Father, I pray that love would be present in and through my life for without it I am bankrupted.

5 Keep Loving Them - Father, I pray that You, O Lord would help me to have the love that never gives up when You say, "keep loving them."

6 Caring Love - Father, I pray that You, O Lord would help me to have a love that cares more for others than for myself when appropriate.

7 Love Without Envy - Father, I pray that You, O Lord would help me to have a love that does not envy.

8 Love That Has Value - Father, I pray that my love would not be a love that brags, boasts and is prideful because then it has no real value.

9 Force My Love - Father, I pray that I would take a step back and never try to force my love upon others when it is not appropriate to do so.

10 Love For Others - Father, I pray that my love for others would be sincere, and help me to hate what is evil, but cling to what is good.

11 Me First! - Father, I pray that my love for others isn't always a love that says, "me first!"

12 Show Patience And Love - Father, I pray that as I interact with others I will not be easily angered or fly off the handle, but show patience and love today.

13 Extend Love - Father, I pray that I would extend love versus keeping score of others' wrongs.

14 Treat With Love And Care - Father, I pray that I would not delight in others shortcomings, mistakes and failures, but treat them with the love and care that You extend me.

15 What Love Does - Father, I pray that I would look for the best in others versus the worst because that's what love does.

16 Not Reflecting Your Love - Father, I pray that I would never be the person who brings up people's wrongs again and again, who does not let others forget their past, or who holds on to unforgiveness because that does not reject Your love.

17 Your Kind Of Love - Father, I pray that I would have Your kind of love towards others, the love that never fails and that covers a multitude of sins.

18 Love My Enemies - Father, I pray that You would help me to love my enemies and do good to them.

19 Love Myself - Father, I pray that You would help me to accept and love myself

20 Love My Neighbor - Father, I pray that You would help me to love my neighbor the way I love myself; doing no harm to them.

21 Patient With One Another In Love - Father, I pray that I would be humble, gentle and also be patient with one another in love.

22 Husbands Love Your Wives - Father, I pray that husbands would love their wives as Christ loved the church, and gave Himself up for her.

23 Apply Love - Father, I pray that I would not stir up conflict, but apply love because it covers all wrongs.

24 To Love You - Father, I pray that I will reverence You, walk in obedience, love You, and serve You with all my heart and soul.

25 Not Awaken Love - Father, I pray that singles will not awaken love until they are ready and it is time.

26 Love The Lord - Father, I pray that I would love You with all my heart, with all my soul and with all my mind.

27 Love Different People - Father, I pray that You would grow me spiritually so that I sincerely love people who do not look like me, act like me or hang out with me.

28 Pure Love - Father, I pray that you would allow my love to be pure towards others and not toxic or self- seeking.

29 Love Grow Stronger - Father, I pray for marriages, may they love one another unconditionally with Your help and may their love for each other grow stronger and stronger each day with Your help.

30 Love For You - Father, I pray that my love for You LORD, will never grow cold.
